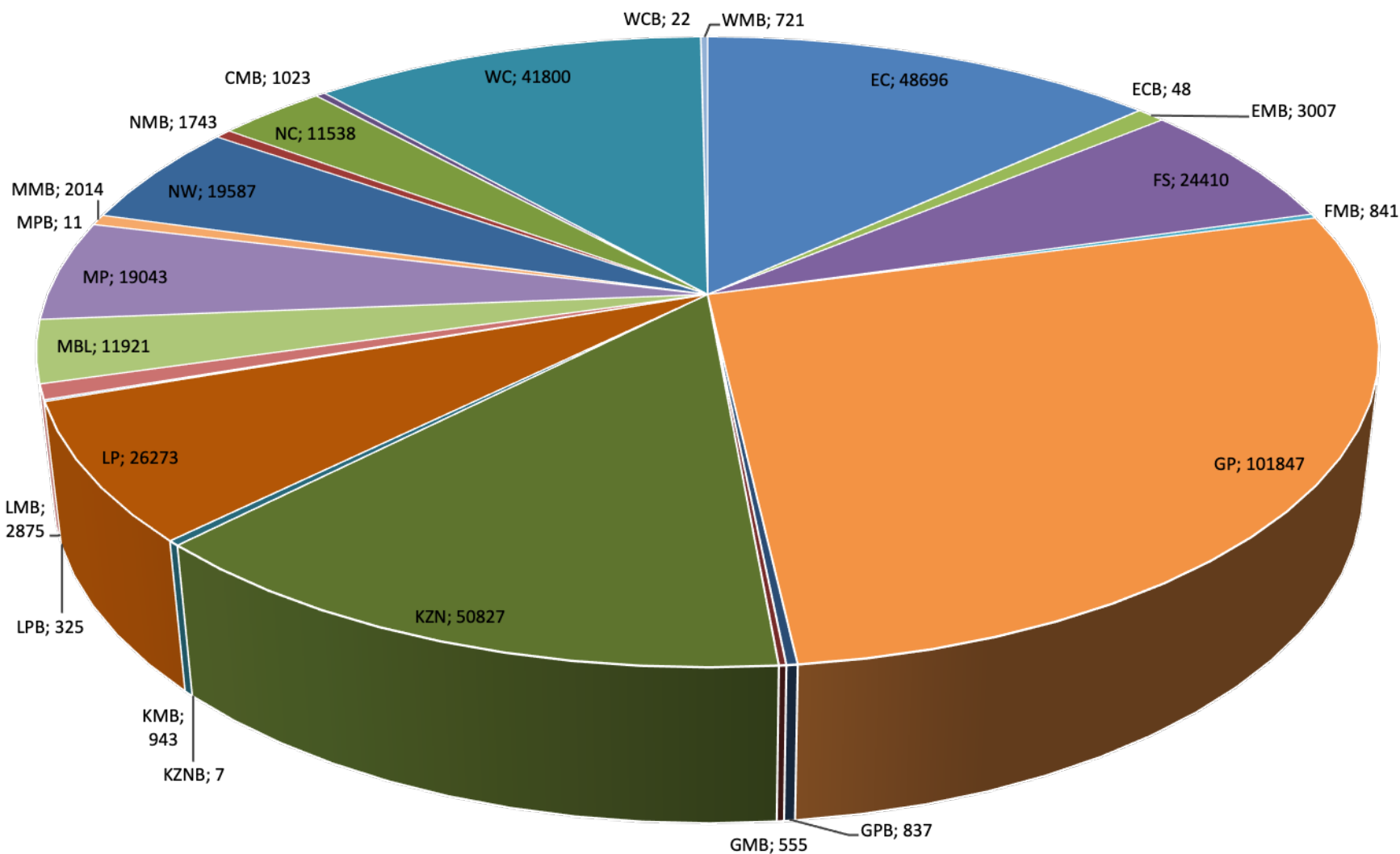

- ☐ Only one office has no generator
- ☐ 13 mobile units to be deployed



Western Cape

- ☐ Total offices to open is 28
- ☐ 27 are modernised – meaning that they can accept Smart ID Card and passport applications
- ☐ Only one office is a legacy office and has no generator
- ☐ Eight mobile units to be deployed
- ☐ Four banks will open only on Saturday – Standard Bank at the Promindade in Mitchells Plain, Nedbank at Green Market Square, FNB in Green Point and Standard Bank in Canel Walk



Eastern Cape

- ☐ Total offices to open is 54
- ☐ 32 are modernised – meaning that they can accept Smart ID Card and passport applications
- ☐ 22 legacy – which means they are not able to take modernised services
- ☐ Of these four have generators
- ☐ 12 mobile units to be deployed



Limpopo

- ☐ Total offices to open is 42

- ☐ 20 legacy – which means they are not able to take modernised services
- ☐ One bank - FNB in Burgersfort
- ☐ 12 mobile units to be deployed



Mpumalanga
